





Recreational Vehicle Rules

- 1. A non ORANZ registered vehicle may participate at an ORANZ permitted Club Day Short Course or sprint event only by purchasing a Recreational Vehicle Day Pass. Recreational vehicles shall not be permitted to enter an Enduro or any Titled or National Championship events. Recreational vehicles must never be on a track with competing registered race vehicles. Drivers must enter with the understanding that they are not racing/competing in any capacity.
- 2, Recreational vehicles are categorised into two categories.
- a) A four wheel, one, two or 4 seat UTV production vehicle with no engine or gearbox performance enhancements. The manufacturers safety features must not have been compromised in anyway. The owner/driver must sign the documentation declaring this. Any performance modifications must be equally met with Safety features approved by the CTO or club tagging official.eg a strengthened roll cage
- b) A space frame offroad vehicle of a recognised built/design like the vehicles being currently tagged for Offroad racing. NO beach buggies, farm hacks, 4wd or road cars with roll hoops etc
- 3, The host club and or any club or ORANZ official reserves the right to refuse any vehicle for a Recreational Vehicle Day Pass if they feel it does not comply or it is unsafe.
- 4, All Drivers and passengers must attend a "drivers briefing" and follow the instructions of officials at all times.
- 5, A pre-event Vehicle Inspection Sheet and all relevant indemnity forms must be filled out and signed by the owner/driver. Passengers must sign indemnity forms. Personal Safety gear as listed on the Pre- event inspection sheet must be always worn by all drivers and passengers on any track.
- (iii) A maximum of 2 club day Recreational Vehicle Day passes per vehicle maybe issued per year and shall be issued in conjunction with a Driver Day licence.
- (iv) The fee for a Club Day Recreational Vehicle pass shall be the same as the fee set for a day licence. I.E. The fee for a Club Day Recreational Vehicle Day Pass and Club Day Driver Licence shall be, the Club Day Driver Licence Fee X 2
- (v) No express or implied warranty of safety shall result from any inspection or information offered.

NOTES

- All Clubs must keep a signed copy of all Driver Day licenses and Recreational Vehicle Day passes they have issued. A copy must be sent to ORANZ at the time or within 5 days of issue by electronic media in accordance with Current Oranz requirements.
- These Recreational Vehicle rules are open to editing without notice throughout the 2025 and 2026 season.
